Report of the Inspection Committee that visited DPG Institute of Technology and Management, Sector-34, Near Hero Honda Chowk, NH-8, Gurgaon with regard to continuation/extension of existing B.Tech. and M.Tech. programmes for the session 2013-14

The Inspection Committee comprising Prof. D. S. Kumar, Prof. J.S. Saint, Prof. D.V.S. Verma, Prof. Nasib Singh Gill and Prof. Manoj Duhan visited DPG Institute of Technology and Management, Sector-34, Near Hero Honda Chowk, NH-8, Gurgaon on 10.08.2013 with regard to grant of provisional affiliation for the following programmes:

- Continuation of B.Tech. 1st year and 2nd year in Computer Sc. & Engg. (CSE), Electronics & Communication Engg. (ECE), Mechanical Engg. (ME), Electrical Engg. (EE) and Civil Engg. (CE) with an intake of 60 each
- Extension of B.Tech. 3rd year in Computer Sc. & Engg. (CSE), Electronics & Communication Engg. (ECE), Mechanical Engg. (ME), Electrical Engg. (EE) and Civil Engg. (CE) with an intake of 18 each
- Continuation of M.Tech. (CSE) 1st year and its extension in 2nd year with an intake of 18 each
- Continuation of M.Tech. (ECE) 1st year and its extension in 2nd year with an intake of 18 each

Observations

In respect of the above proposal, the observations of the committee are as under:

1. Compliance: The Institute has partially fulfilled the conditions imposed by the previous Inspection Committee. The Institute lacks in terms of Labs, eligible faculty as well as appointment of senior faculty as per AICTE prescribed cadre ratio.
2. AICTE Approval: AICTE has already granted approval to the Institute for all the above programmes for the session 2013-14. (Copy enclosed)
3. Admissions: The Institute could attract about 240 students against 300 sanctioned intake in B.Tech 1st semester in the session 2013-14.
4. Building: The Institute has a double storey having an adequate built-up area to meet out the requirements of all the above programmes. The building of the Institute houses Director Office, Admin office, Reception Lounge, Counseling Rooms, Pantry, Board Room, Washrooms, Classrooms, Tutorial Rooms, Chemistry Lab, Physics Lab, Drawing Hall, ET Lab, ECE Lab, BME Lab, Civil Engg. Labs, Seminar Halls, Common Rooms (for Boys & Girls), other laboratories, etc.

5. Staff: Beside Principal, the Institute has an existing 47 faculty members (2 Professors, 3 Associate Professors and 42 Asstt. Professors/Proform Lecturers) and 10 identified faculty against a requirement of overall 66 faculty (7 Professors, 15 Associate Professors and 44 Asstt. Professors). Major chunk of the existing

Faculty is neither eligible nor MDU/AICTE laid procedure has been followed for recruitments. Further the faculty lacks at senior level for all the courses. The Institute is also required to appoint faculty as per AICTE/MDU norms and in the prescribed cadre ratio. (Details enclosed)

6. Laboratories: The Committee visited the all the labs relating to Computer Science & Engineering, Electronics & Communication Engg., Mechanical Engineering, Electrical Engineering, Civil Engg., Physics Lab, Chemistry Lab and workshops. Since the session has already started and the Institute is yet to setup the labs pertaining to 5th semester for all B.Tech. courses as well as M.Tech. 3rd semester in CSE & ECE. Labs for M.Tech ECE 1st year and CSE 1st year are also not existent. The Institute is advised to expedite the process of establishing the labs required for the current semester. Each lab has to have proper display board having Time-Table and List of Experiments. (Details enclosed)

7. Library: The Institute has a library having in all 7624 books (520 titles) related to Engg. Courses, which includes books related to Book Bank also. The Institute has placed an order of 1573 books (47 titles). The College is required to have minimum 400 books each related to M.Tech. (ECE) and M.Tech. (CSE). The Institute is required to have an access to Reading Hall from Library. The Institute has no regular subscription of journals, however, the Institute is advised to separate Book Bank from the main Library. However, the College is advised to add adequate titles as well as subscription of standard journals of repute. (Details enclosed)

8. Computer Lab: The Institute has 7 Computer Labs and One Computer Centre housing 195 P-IV computers, one Server, 19 Printers and 26 printers as per AICTE/MDU norms. The Institute has an MSDN agreement for software, however, the deficient software for the required labs need to be procured at the earliest. There is an Internet connection of 4 MBPS from Tata. (Details and Bills enclosed)

9. The Institute has 12 Lecture Halls, 6 Tutorial Rooms and 20 Laboratories. However, all the classrooms are required to have proper visibility of white-boards to its students.

10. The Institute has hostel accommodation for about 150 students on the Campus.

11. The Institute has 5 Gensets of total 200 KVA.

12. Undertaking: The Principal has given undertaking a time-bound undertaking for compliance of the deficiencies pointed out above. (Copy enclosed)

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Recommendations

In view of the above observations, the committee recommends that DPG Institute of Technology and Management, Sector-34, Near Hero Honda Chowk, NH-8, Gurgaon may be granted provisional affiliation for the following:

- Continuation of B.Tech. 1st year and 2nd year in Computer Sc. & Engg. (CSE), Electronics & Communication Engg. (ECE), Mechanical Engg. (ME), Electrical Engg. (EE) and Civil Engg. (CE) with an intake of 60 each
 - Extension of B.Tech. 3rd year in Computer Sc. & Engg. (CSE), Electronics & Communication Engg. (ECE), Mechanical Engg. (ME), Electrical Engg. (EE) and Civil Engg. (CE) with an intake of 60 each
 - Continuation of M.Tech. (CSE) 1st year and its extension in 2nd year with an intake of 18 each
 - Continuation of M.Tech. (ECE) 1st year and its extension in 2nd year with an intake of 18 each
- for the session 2013-14 subject to the verification of the compliance of the deficiencies pointed out above by the committee on or before October 10, 2013.
