Inspection Report of DPG institute of Technology & Management, Gurgaon regarding checking of compliance report-matter regarding grant of extension/continuation in provisional affiliation for existing courses/intakes for/from the sessions 2020-21

The Inspection Committee consisting of the following visited the above said institute on 04.03.2021 to check previous compliance report and to verify the availability of requisite infrastructure facilities, constitution of Governing Body, faculty and other support system in order to consider the matter for granting extension/continuation in provisional affiliation for existing courses/intakes i.e B.Tech. (CSE=60, ECE=30, EE=30, ME=60, CE=30), M.Tech.(ECE=18, CSE=36), BBA=120 seats & BCA=120 seats ,B.Tech. CSE (Artificial Intelligence and Machine learning=60 seats and B.Tech. CSE (Data science) =30 seats for the

Observations of the Committee: The inspection committee physically inspected and verified the infrastructural facilities viz. buildings, various labs, staff, library, class rooms, furniture, etc. for the above mentioned courses. On the basis of inspection, the observations of the committees are as under:

- 1. Compliance: The Institute has partially satisfied the conditions imposed by the previous inspection committee. Faculty at the level of Professor, Associate Professor is required as per AICTE/ MDU norms. Appointment of the entire faculty should be made through proper selection committee as per MDU/ AICTE norms and procedure
- 2. AICTE Approval: The Institute has obtained the approval of AICTE for running the programmes/courses with approved intakes for the sessions 2020-21. (EOA letter of AICTE attached in the file).
- 3. CM Grievance/ PM Grievance: As informed by the Director of the institute, there is no grievance pending towards the Institute.(Undertaking enclosed)
- 4. Faculty: As per the list submitted by the institute, the Institute has 70 faculty members including one Director (salary sheet is attached). Only 8 faculty members are approved/proceedings approved. Faculty including Professors and Assistant Professors has to be appointed in proper cadre ratio as per Professors, Associate faculty appointments including appointment of the Director/Principal should be got approved as per MDU norms by the office of the DCDC, MDUR. Also the institute is required to appoint faculty members for B.Tech. CSE (Artificial Intelligence and Machine learning) and B.Tech. CSE (Data science) as per AICTE/MDU norms.
- 5. Laboratories: The institute has adequate laboratories. Institute is advised to maintain/add computing facilities, equipments and required software for all the programmes as per AICTE/MDU norms.

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- 6. **Library:** The Institute has a library having 25321 books and 4695 titles including e books related to all the above mentioned programmes. Institute is advised to add more books/journals, specifically for BBA, BCA B.Tech. CSE (Artificial Intelligence and Machine learning and B.Tech. CSE (Data science) seats as per norms of MDU.
- 7. The Institute has a good building having classrooms, tutorial rooms, seminar rooms, computer labs, Director Office, faculty cabins for all the aforesaid programmes.
- 8. The Mandatory disclosure is hoisted on the website of the institute but is not updated. The institute has submitted the hard copy of college portal data to MDU for the session 2016-17 only.
- 9. Governing body/BoG of the Institute is constituted.
- 10. Institute is not accredited by NAAC/NBA

Recommendations:

The institute has secured less than 50% marks in any of the three facilities mentioned in the performa of all the above mentioned courses, (Performas enclosed). The institute has given an undertaking that the faculty approval process will be completed within the next academic session. In view of the above observations, the committee recommends that the institute may be granted permission for extension/continuation of all the above mentioned programmes approved by the AICTE & MDU with approved intake for the session 2020-21 subject to the compliance of the above deficiencies pointed out by the committee. Report is submitted along with the documents and inspection proforma(s) as submitted by the institute.
