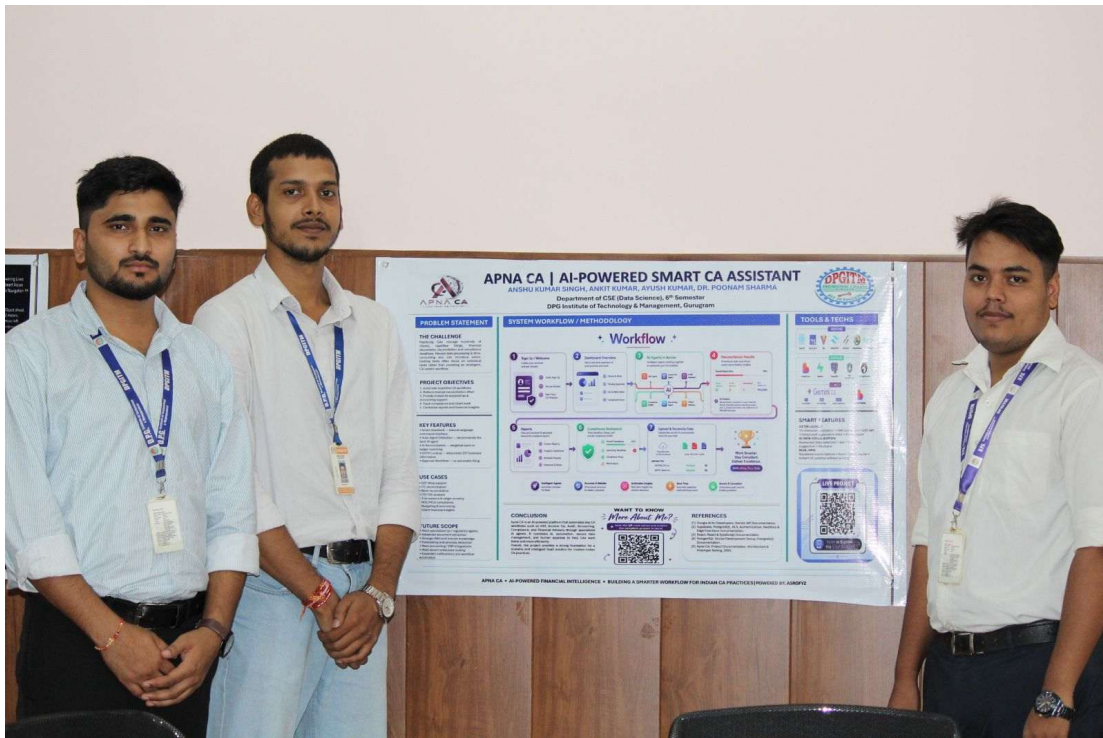
4. **Outcomes:** Students gained the following skills and insights:
